Visual Arts Area

Artist Attendant - Our seated artists (Visual, Culinary, film) need an attendant. This person helps out the artists by directing them to their table and helping with set-up and/or take-down if needed. He/she would also answer questions, bring water, and sit at the table should the artist need to leave it for a short time (for washroom breaks, a short walk, or to grab lunch, etc.). Also an attendant would draw attention to artists who perhaps aren't getting as much as others.

Visual Arts Activity Attendant

In our Installation Art Area, we have 5 tents containing common-to-the-public materials. Four of the tents have dedicated artists who will be using the materials to create sculptures throughout the day. The purpose is to showcase the creation process. I believe there may be a competition involved with this too where the audience votes for a winner. The 5th tent is open to the public to try their hand at creating their own sculpture. This tent will need an attendant. The primary responsibility of this position is to monitor safety. However, it would also be helpful to have somewhere there who can offer advice and be encouraging to those who start and give-up before they finish.

In the "Shape My World" area, participants create a picture using shapes (I believe they are paper cut-outs).

StageHand - If you're looking for a more physical job, our music and dance stages require stagehands.

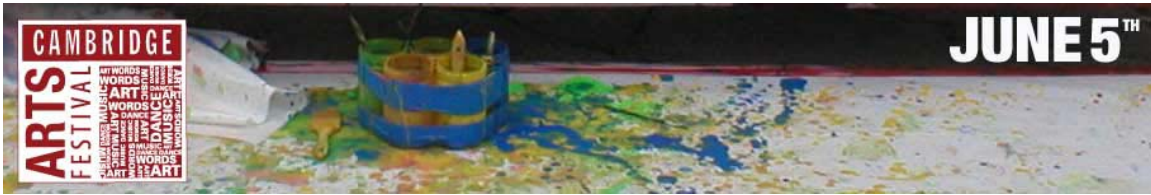
Literary

Backstage Coordinator - Our Literary stage is in need of a back-stage coordinator who would be responsible for ensuring the performers stick to the schedule and that performers are ready to go when their time comes. Also, this person would be supportive and encouraging to our less confident/experienced presenters.

Attendant - Our "Word-Up" activity is also in need of an attendant. This is a magnetic poetry activity where passer-by's create poems or messages using magnetic words on a line of fridge doors.
