Poetry Contest

RULES

Poems must:

- Be the original work of the poet, written in English
- Not a prize winner in a previous competition
- Be typed, single-spaced on 8^{1/2}" x 11" plain white paper
- Use a clear 12-point type. No fancy fonts or coloured text.

Rules:

Do not include a SASE. Manuscripts will not be returned. No faxed or emailed submissions are allowed. The winning entries will be published in the 2010 Cambridge Arts Festival program and the winning authors will be invited to read their pieces at the festival, Saturday, June 5, 2010.

Judging is blind. *Do not put your name and address on your manuscript.* Instead, include the completed entry form, or a cover page with the title(s) of your submission, age category, and your name and address, phone number, and email address.

One Poetry Entry is up to 3 poems with no more than 35 lines per poem (including spaces between verses) and a 60-character maximum line width (including spaces and punctuation).

Entry Fee: \$5 per poem, or \$10 for 3 poems. Make your cheque or money order payable to the *Cambridge Arts Festival* and enclose it with your entry.

Entry deadline: Entry must be postmarked no later than Friday, April 16, 2010
